Restorative Justice allows you to:

- Share how you have been affected by the harm that has occurred.
- Find answers to some of your questions.
- Have input into the outcome of the case.
- Meet in a safe environment with the person(s) who harmed you, if they are willing to accept responsibility for their actions.

Advantages of Restorative Justice:

- **LOW COST:** Most services are available at no cost.
- **CONTROL:** Unlike the court system, this is your process. Trained facilitators help manage the sessions, ask questions and help everyone to be heard. You make decisions about how things are resolved as part of the process.
- **CONFIDENTIAL:** Sessions and case files are private - no disclosure outside of the process.
- **QUICK:** A session can be scheduled within 30 days.
